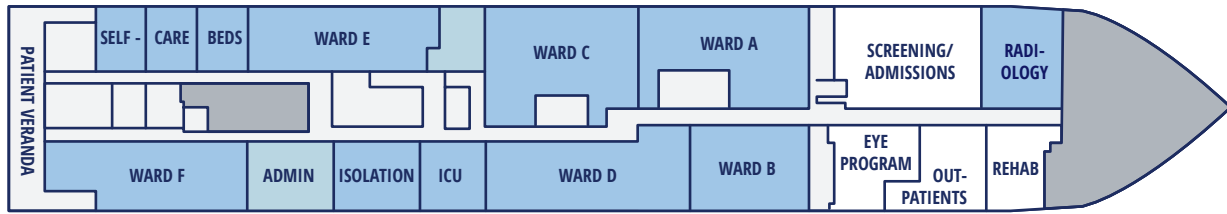
Mannequins & Other Training Tools

The simulation lab will allow trainers to **simulate local conditions & limitations** in order to teach **best practices** in **low-resource environments**.

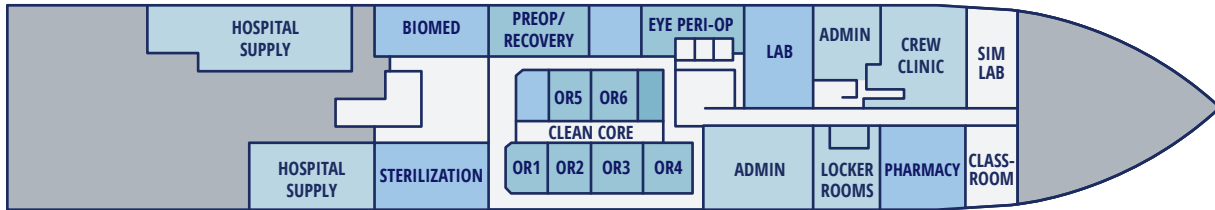
Training opportunities include:

- Live surgical mentoring in selected high demand, elective procedures

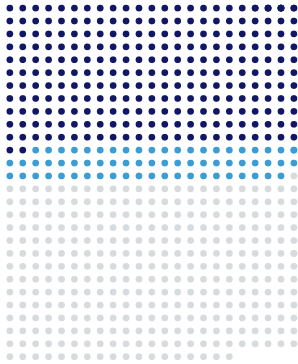
HOSPITAL WARDS - DECK 4
